
## Planting Trees: Standard of Care Timeline



Whether trees are planted in the spring or the fall, it is important to help them establish. The first three years are vital to growing healthy trees that will continue to support our urban canopy.


#### Years 1-3



#### Weed, Stake + Tie

- Twice a month remove weeds from each mulch ring.
- · Weeds should not encroach on the mulch bed. Remove all pulled weeds from the area and dispose of properly
- At least two stakes per tree.
  - · Additional stakes to be added as needed for stabilization of the tree or as a deterrent for mowers and equipment.
- In year one and continuing until the tree demonstrates adequate resistance to high winds secure tree to the stakes using twine.
- Each tree should have a trunk guard securely tied with 1 inch of overlap to prevent deer from accessing the trunk.
  - Trees experiencing deer browse will be fenced with cages.
